

ROLLED BANDAGES

Lutheran Women's Missionary League—Canada

...for Medical Missions

- Use clean, used sheets – cotton or flannelette (preferably white)
- Tear into strips 2" or 3" wide
- Join strips, as required, with a flat seam sewn by hand or machine.
- Roll the strips; resulting roll should be no larger than 3" in diameter
- Tack the end with a couple of stitches to hold.

Bandages are shipped to Lutheran Hospitals in the Philippines, Papua, New Guinea, Malappuram Welfare Centre in Kerala, India, and to many Bible Translators in New Guinea and Africa.
