LWMLC Supports Mission Effort in Quebec

Your General Council recently approved the allotment of \$5,000 from the Mission Opportunity Fund for a Reformation anniversary outreach effort in Quebec. This project has several different components, including a travelling display with the working title of “Martin Luther as Translator” which Rev. Dr. David Somers is developing in partnership with the Montreal office of the Canadian Bible Society. The outreach component includes the use of Project Connect booklets, the French Lutheran hymnal, and other contemporary confessional Lutheran materials which have been translated into French included in the display.

Some of it will be available for those who visit the display to take with them. Information will also be part of the display, letting people know about the mission work LCC East District is doing in Quebec.

An initial \$1,000 will help start the project with the balance to follow. It is exciting how God uses LWMLC to help open doors for LCC in Quebec. To God alone be the glory!

Be sure to check out Rev. Somers' article in the winter issue of *Tapestry* which will be mailed soon. He shares some practical ideas based on the 500th anniversary of the Reformation that societies and individuals may use in sharing the Gospel.
