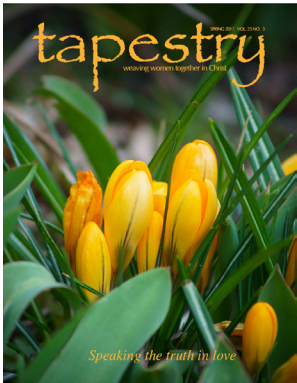

The most urgent need is **someone to create the audio version**. After several years as a volunteer

producing the audio version and as assistant editor of *Tapestry*, Kathy Birkett has found she needs to go in a different direction. We thank her for the wonderful help she has provided both as assistant editor and with the unrelated task of preparing the audio version. There are several women who appreciate receiving *Tapestry* on CD so we are looking for a new volunteer. A clear reading voice and a means of doing the recording are needed. This position has most recently been filled by an assistant editor but that is not a requirement.

We are also looking for a **new assistant editor** to replace Kathy. A good knowledge of grammar and spelling are most important as are creative ideas for articles to develop a theme and a knowledge of possible authors. If you enjoy writing, that would help although the editors don't usually do a great deal of the writing.

Something new, **an advisory group**, doesn't require writing or editing skills although they could be helpful. This group will meet with the editors online for theme development and finding writers for articles related to the themes. We hope to have a variety of ages and life experiences in this group to bring forward ideas that appeal to a broad range of readers.

We are also looking for someone to serve as an **assistant to the current data manager** with the goal of becoming data manager. Accuracy, attention to detail and a reasonably good knowledge of LWML—Canada are important as well as some specific computer skills.
