MISSION GRANT PAYMENTS

Final portion of the grant for LCC's project in Atlantic Canada has been paid. Pastor Ron Mohr expressed his gratitude for our continued support in planting and maintaining congregations. See details in the coming issue of Tapestry.

Remaining \$2,000 of the \$5,000 grant from Mission Opportunity Fund for the Quebec Outreach Reformation 500 activities has been paid. Both Pastor Ron Mohr and Dr. David Somers sounded their appreciation for LWMLC help with the project.

New Payments from the Mission Opportunity Fund

General Council approved payment of \$3,000 to LCC to sustain mission work in Thailand. This funding may allow the education of more mission helpers.

General Council approved a request to cover shipping cost of \$766.84 (US\$605) of Good News magazines in Spanish to St. Louis, Mo, with a final destination of Nicaragua.

\$500 was granted for CPH Tracts, LLL Project Connect booklets, Bibles, etc. for distribution by the Stratford Circuit congregations who fund and operate a booth at the 100th International Ploughing Match, held September 19-23 at Walton, Ontario, near Dashwood.

Remaining in the 2015 – 2018 triennium Mission Opportunity Fund \$10,633.16.
