Praise God! Mission grant payments continue to be made

For Cambodia:

- With the advent of a newly formed church in Cambodia, the Cambodia Lutheran Church, we were able to pay the remaining sum of \$5,967.50 allotted to support the evangelist deaconesses.

- \$3,000 held back the from support for the sewing school was paid as seed money to establish a new sewing school at a different location.

For Nicaragua:

- \$900 has been forwarded to Lutheran Church–Canada in support of the Evangelist Deaconesses and \$720 for the Education and Feeding centre Rancheria.

For Atlantic Canada:

- \$3,000 from the Mission Opportunity Fund has been approved by General Council for outreach visits in Atlantic Canada.

Look for more detail in *Staying Connected, Spring 2017*, coming out in mid-March.

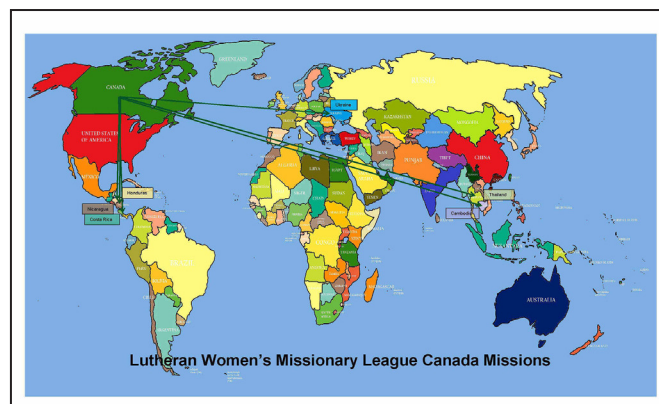
As reported in spring *Tapestry*, \$775 was set aside from LWMLC's Mission Opportunity Fund to pay for the purchase of Spanish language catechisms to be distributed during a VBS visit in Nicaragua. Actual cost was \$555.45.
