Excerpts from Tapestry – another way to “share God’s Word”

LWML–Canada has begun a blog called *Excerpts from Tapestry*. Once a month we will post a “story of the month” and once a month we will post a “study of the month” from back issues of the magazine. We have two purposes in mind. The first, we will admit, is self-serving because we hope to grow the number of subscribers and thereby enable us to keep printing well into the future.
