Christ Lives! The Easter Good News: John 20:21-23; Acts 2:14, 22-25, 30-33

Christ Lives! The Good News from Pentecost: Acts 2:14, 22-25, 30-33

The 'Lynch Pin' of Christianity: 1 Corinthians 15:1-5, 15:14-12

Christ Lives! Proves Four Truths:

#1. Jesus is the Son of God: John 11:25-27; Romans 1:1-4; 1 Timothy 3:16

#2. Jesus' doctrine is Truth: John 1:14; John 2:18-19; John 14:6; 1 Timothy 2:3-6; 1 John 1:6-9

#3. God accepted Christ's sacrifice for the sins of the world: John 3:16-17; Romans 8:1-4; Colossians 1:21-22; Galatians 4:4-5; 2 Corinthians 5:21

#4. Because Christ Lives, all believers in Christ will be raised to everlasting life: John 5:21, 24; John 6:40; 1 John 5:10-12; Romans 6:22-23
