Based on the biblical story of the widow's mite (Luke 21:1-4 KJV), "mites" — offerings above and beyond the support given to the congregation and the synod — are collected by women of Lutheran Church–Canada. Mite contributions amount to thousands of dollars, supporting LWML–Canada district and national grants to mission projects around the world as well as implementing the LWML–Canada program.

40% — For national mission grants and mission program  
 60% — For district mission grants and mission program

Mite envelopes, available from the LWML–Canada Resource Centre, are distributed to every woman in a society.

Mite offerings are gathered at meetings, preferably with prayer or special devotions.

Society treasurers remit contributions monthly to the district treasurer or other designated person (some districts send mites through their zone treasurer).
