PAY 27

HE MAKES A WAY

Behold, I am doing a new thing; now it springs forth, do you not perceive it? I will make a way in the wilderness and rivers in the desert (Isaiah 43:19).

PAY 28

CITIZENSHIP IN HEAVEN

But our citizenship is in heaven, and from it we await a Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ (Philippians 3:20).

PAY 29


GOD WILL UPHOLD YOU

...fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God; I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand (Isaiah 41:10).

PAY 30

HE WILL NEVER LEAVE YOU

It is the LORD who goes before you. He will be with you; He will not leave you or forsake you. Do not fear or be dismayed (Deuteronomy 31:8).

PAY 20

GOD WILL LEAD AND TEACH YOU

He leads the humble in what is right, and teaches the humble His way (Psalm 25:9).

DAY 21

A FIRM FOUNDATION

From the ends of the earth I call to you, I call as my heart grows faint; lead me to the rock that is higher than I (Psalm 61:2).

DAY 22

THE PROMISE OF MERCY

Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need (Hebrews 4:16).

PAY 23

GOD PROMISES GOOD THINGS

Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights with whom there is no variation or shadow due to change (James 1:17).

DAY 24

GOD WILL RENEW OUR STRENGTH

But they who wait for the Lord shall renew their strength, they shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint (Isaiah 40:31).

PAY 25

THE PROMISE OF ETERNAL LIFE

For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life (John 3:16).

DAY 15

GOD WILL GUIDE YOU

Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make straight your paths (Proverbs 3:5-6).

DAY 16

REST FOR OUR SOULS

Come to me, all who labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you, and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls (Matthew 11:28-29).

DAY 17

THE PROMISE OF WISDOM

If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him. But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea that is driven and tossed by the wind (James 1:5-6).

DAY 18

GUARDING OUR HEARTS AND MINDS

...do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus (Philippians 4:6-7).

DAY 19

GOD WILL NOT LET YOU FALL

The steps of a man are established by the LORD, when he delights in His way; though he fall, he shall not be cast headlong, for the LORD upholds his hand (Psalm 37:23-24).

DAY 1

NOTHING CAN SEPARATE US FROM GOD'S LOVE

For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord (Romans 8:38).

PAY 2

EVERYTHING WILL WORK OUT FOR GOOD

And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to His purpose (Romans 8:28).

PAY 3

YOU ARE A NEW CREATION

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come (2 Corinthians 5:17).

DAY 4

THE PROMISE OF PROTECTION

For He will deliver you from the snare of the fowler and from the deadly pestilence (Psalm 91:3).

DAY 5

HEALING IS YOURS

He Himself bore our sins in His body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By His wounds you have been healed (1 Peter 2:24).

You keep him in perfect peace whose mind is stayed on You, because he trusts in You (Isaiah 26:3).

When we readjust our thinking from the "what ifs" and "what could have been" and we focus on trusting Jesus, we can experience steadfast peace.

DAY 6

GOD WILL BE NEAR

Draw near to God, and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded (James 4:8).

DAY 7

PROMISE OF PROSPERITY AND NOT HARM

For I know the plans I have for you, declares the LORD, plans for welfare and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope (Jeremiah 29:11).

DAY 8

THERE IS NO CONDEMNATION

There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus (Romans 8:1).

DAY 9

THE PROMISE OF BLESSING

And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you, if you obey the voice of the LORD your God. Blessed shall you be in the city, and blessed shall you be in the field. Blessed shall be the fruit of your womb and the fruit of your ground and the fruit of your cattle, the increase of your herds and the young of your flock. Blessed shall be your basket and your kneading bowl. Blessed shall you be when you come in, and blessed shall you be when you go out (Deuteronomy 28:2-6).

DAY 10

YOU HAVE VICTORY

No, despite all these things, overwhelming victory is ours through Christ, who loved us (Romans 8:37).

DAY 11

OUR TRIALS HAVE PURPOSE

Count it all joy, my brothers, when you meet trials of various kinds, for you know that the testing of your faith produces steadfastness (James 1:2-3).

DAY 12

THE PROMISE OF COMFORT

...who comforts us in all our affliction, so that we may be able to comfort those who are in any affliction, with the comfort with which we ourselves are comforted by God. For as we share abundantly in Christ's sufferings, so through Christ we share abundantly in comfort too (2 Corinthians 1:4-5).

DAY 13

THE PROMISE OF STRENGTH

But He said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me. That is why, for Christ's sake, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong (2 Corinthians 12:9-10).

DAY 14

GOD PROMISES TO LEAD YOU

I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you with My eye upon you (Psalm 32:8).
