BIBLE STUDIES

Am I a Servant like Martha or Like Mary? (Bible Study) As women, the story of Martha and Mary is one we can all relate to. As in this study, you may have asked the question, “was Martha treated fairly over Mary?” or “what does this mean for me in service to my church and my Lord? Am I a Martha or a Mary? This Bible study is in two parts, Part 1 concerns itself with Martha and Mary and their relationship with Jesus. Part 2 deals with our servanthood in light of Scripture. It comes complete with a leader’s guide and participant pages. 7 pages C-20-01

Anchored in the Lord (Study) based on Hebrews 6:19-20. Using the analogy that we are ships sailing on the seas of this life moving towards our destination heaven’s harbour, sometimes through calm waters (times of peace and contentment) sometimes through wind and waves (times of doubt and fear) it is comforting to know we have an anchor of hope in Jesus to hold us safe and secure. This study reaffirms our sure hope and confidence in the Lord to see us through. Scriptures passages are printed out in the study, 21 pages C-14-13-CD4

(NEW) Backseat Worker, The (Study) We’re all known somehow, Bible reference, John 1:29-42. This study looks at the life of four fisherman, Andrew, Peter, James and John and asks 5 questions. What is a backseat worker? What is a front seat worker? Why is there a difference? How can the two work together in everyday life? How do they work together in the Father’s Kingdom? 2 pages C-23-01

But, What Happens When I’m Alone? (Study) Explores God’s Word for hope and comfort when we feel alone, helping us find the answer to the question, “Are Christians ever really alone?” 2 pages C-08-01-CD2

Celebration of Our Baptism, A (Study) Looks at our spiritual birthday and what happened on the day of our baptism. 2 pages C-12-56-CD3

Company’s Coming Soon! (Advent Study) Are you ready? This study will help you prepare for the arrival of our King. Excellent for involving all women of the congregation in small group Bible study. (4 sessions) 13 pages C-10-11

Danger of Complacency, The (Bible Study) Based on Matthew 24:36-44 as in the days of Noah and Luke 17:20-30 as in the days of Lot, this Bible study focuses on the complacency of the people then

and now. The two dangers of complacency looked at are that of self and that of others. It speaks to us of the personal danger if we lack faith in the one true God, or if we trust in ourselves rather than Him for salvation. 4 Pages C-22-14

David and Jonathan (Study) 1 Samuel 20 reveals the incredible friendship between David and Johnathan, their unconditional love in a deep relationship as true friends and the challenges that they had to deal with. It challenges us in our friendships and takes us to the ultimate friendship we have in Christ our Savior. Participant/leaders guide included. 10 pages C14-14-CD4

Dear God Why? (Study) A thorough study of “Why do bad things happen to good people?” You will discuss who are the good people, what are the bad things, what does scripture say about evil, learn from the prayers of God’s people, God’s answers to prayers of why and how His wisdom and His promises help us today. All scripture passages are printed out in this study for your convenience. 11 pages C-13-42-CD4

Digging Into His Word-An Adventure in Learning (Study) A different approach to learning God’s Word using techniques one might use in preparing to write a play or movie. No writing is required in

this study of the prodigal son (Luke 15:11-32) but it does suggest an interesting thought process for the study 2 pages C-13-38-CD4

Down in the Valley (Study) This study looks at the discouragement and depression experienced by Elijah as a way to help us understand and see God’s hand when we, too, face “Valley Times” in our lives. 2 pages C1996-02-CD1

Draw Near to God (Study) Hebrews 4 a study on our relationship with God and how Jesus our Prophet, Priest and King draws us into that closer relationship with Him. Participant/leaders guide included. 10 pages C14-12-CD4

Everywhere I Travel (Study) The author shares her “travel bug” and encourages us to explore the many aspects of travel. Included are “reflection breaks” with questions suitable for discussion. 3 pages C2003PE09-CD1

Fan into Flame the Gift of God (Study) Based on 2 Timothy 1. All of us have received the gift of the Word in our lives. This gift can grow cold and die if we don’t continually “fan the flame”. This study will teach us how to fan this spark of faith so that it not only grows in us but is spread to others and so fulfill God’s will

and purpose for His people. Notes for leaders included.

Feet! Feet! Feet! (Study) leader's guide) Looks at the marvelous gift God has given us in our feet, and points out that the best job our feet can do for our Lord is taking us to share the love of Jesus, bringing others into God's family for eternity.

Follow the Leader (Study) Whether you are a leader or teacher within your congregations, or LWMLC, or you are a leader in your home or community, you will benefit from this study. Excellent Study to build confidence in leadership roles. Scripture passages included for your convenience.

(NEW) Generation Gap, The (Study) An interesting Bible study that takes a serious look at the generation gap. Kids don't understand things that we grew up with and we don't understand things they are growing up with. One area of difference is in the technological area, where we who are less knowledgeable are referred to as "digital immigrants" and those who are naturals are "digital natives". One of the greatest challenges

today is to encourage the next generation in the Christian faith, it's difficult since we don't connect with their priorities, it's like we speak a different language. This study guides us through many OT passages to show us how the Israelites were expected to pass the faith on to the next generation and encourages us how to follow their example and figure out ways how we might do this.

God's People Called to Serve (Study)

Based on Deuteronomy 10 including LWML-Canada's motto taken from verse 12 "Called to Serve". This study looks at what it means to be God's chosen people and what he requires from us in response to His love. Answer guide included.

God's Plan for Our Lives (Study) This study on John 15:1-11 reminds us that we indeed have a purpose.

4 pages C1997-04-CD1

(NEW) Great I am, Moses and You! The (Bible Study) An encouraging Bible study for all God's people. It starts with Moses in Exodus 3 and bring us up to today and you. Moses felt unworthy and not capable of doing what God asked of him and we have a tendency to do the same. In this study we learn God's name "I Am", it is a name that reveals His essential quality that God is with us

"Now". The Great I Am is our Triune God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. That should be greatly comforting to all of us. We may not feel worthy or capable but God makes us worthy and enables us to accomplish great things for Him.

Hands, Hands, Hands (Study) God created our hands in a marvelous way. With the support of Scripture, this study leads us through the positive, the negative, the hope, and the service our hands can do.

Holy Spirit – Lord and Giver of Life (Study) A comprehensive study of the work of the Holy Spirit. Seeing the work of the Holy Spirit will help us in our understanding and will strengthen our faith and help us to witness to those around us. You will see Him as True God, sent by the Father and promised by Jesus and how He works in us to create faith, sanctifies us, helps us to witness and pray, gives us gifts and guides us and blesses us. Scripture verses included.

Hope: unshakable comfort of the unchanging God (Study) We live in a world where we experience constant change in people, societies, customs and morality. Change is inevitable whether it is for good or evil. We find unshakable comfort in knowing God does not

change. Study His Word and hear what God has to say about change and hold onto His unchanging promises. You have forgiveness and eternal life in Christ.

Hope: the ultimate agent of change (Bible Study) As the title suggests "hope is the ultimate agent of change" and gives the definition of "the expectation of future good." What does hope mean to you? This study explores the meaning of Christian hope that changes lives, a gift of the Holy Spirit along with faith and love.

Humble and Kind (Study) Based on Luke 18:9-14 especially verse 14b "For everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, but the one who humbles himself will be exalted." While we can comprehend what it means to be humble in our brains, actually being humble is something that proceeds from our hearts. This study will give a clear understanding of what it means to be humble.

Is Anybody Listening? (Study) Does God really hear and answer prayer? Sixteen passages with reflective questions.

Light in the Darkness, The (Study)

This study will take you through 8 doors based on scripture that will open God’s Word in your life in (1) Liturgy, (2) Baptism, (3) Confession & Absolution, (4) Preaching, (5) Lord’s Supper (6) Prayer & Devotion, (7) Bible Study, and (8) Fellowship.

Ready, Set, Stretch (Study) Using the analogy of a new born baby and then leading us through God’s word, this study teaches us what a baby does naturally from the beginning of life. This little one with its ready, set stretch formula is growing, reaching new horizons, extending to new limits, experiencing change. Through God’s Word we are encouraged and learn from His example how to adjust to changes that come our way in our personal life, in that of our LWMLC and challenges in our areas of service within our church or community. With the help of our Lord and trusting in Him we are ready to stretch out to accept new goals, new plans, new ideas.

Resting in Jesus (Study) From Old Testament times to the present-day God’s people have struggled with unrest, feelings of helplessness, even to the point of wanting to run away from it all. This study leads us through scripture to

Sacrifices and Blessings (Study for Lent)

The study examines who Christ is, what He surrendered, who we are, our sacrifices and the blessings we receive. While weekly study is the optimal way for use, it could be adapted for use at a retreat. (5 Sessions)

God...Body...Mind...Spirit (Study) Based on Romans 12:1-8; helps us discover how we serve God with our whole being.

Turn Around – Repent And Believe

(Study) Learn how to acknowledge our faults, stop blaming others and repent.

We Give Our All...to Praise Our God

(Study) Based on the LWML-Canada Pledge. Excellent study that opens up the scriptures that back up every line of the pledge we so dearly love to recite. It gives us the opportunity to stop and reflect on the how’s and why’s and to whom we offer our fervent gratitude.

4 pages C-14-16-CD4

We, not Me (Study) In today’s society individuals are encouraged to shine on their own with the emphasis on what they can accomplish. While God created us as unique individuals, He also made us a part of a larger community to be interactive with one another that we may build one another up. This study explores God’s provisions for preserving our individuality within being part of His Kingdom.

What Kind of Thanksgiving? (Study)

Helps us understand the Gospel-type of Thanksgiving, one that is inspired by the gospel of the crucified and risen Christ. It asks, why do we say thank you anyway? Why, do we especially say thank you to God? It looks at various types of Thanksgiving such as Guilt Inspired, Relative to Others, and Hokey Thanksgiving in comparison to the Gospel Inspired Thanksgiving.

What is Love? A Bible Study on

Domestic Abuse: This study examines domestic abuse from the prospective of God’s definition of love and His will for our lives so that abuse will be exposed for the sin that it is. You will study the effect that abuse has on individuals as well as examples from the Bible. You will share the hope God gives for a plan of action, repentance and forgiveness, His

wisdom and promises to help those affected by abuse. All scripture passages included.

Advent/Christmas Devotion On Light - Revised 2024 (Devotion) As you go through this devotion you will be blessed by all the ways God has referenced Light for our eternal benefit. Nine candles are needed, a leader and 8 readers or a leader with 1 reader. You may choose to use hymnals (lights on when singing and then turned off) or a power point of hymns can be requested through dod@lutheranwomen.ca under **C-1995-09 power point**. As the devotion begins

all lights are off except for the leader's candle.

After Christmas, what then? (Devotion) Christmas ends, Epiphany begins. God's gift to us keeps on giving, He is still with us even though everything else has been put away and Christ's light will continue to shine for us and through us. Called to Speak (Webinar/Video-Written Script) Purposeful conversations of Christ centered faith! The inspiration for this webinar came from a presentation by Lisa Jackson from Lutheran Laymen's League and Lutheran Hour Ministries, titled "Spiritual Conversations" along with the book "The Reluctant Witness" by Dan Everts. The webinar covers three spiritual postures of people toward the Gospel (Unreceptive Non-Christians; Receptive Non-Christians; Seeking Non-Christians) and six types of conversations to have with those spiritual postures. By these examples we learn how to adapt our conversations with our non-Christian friends. The key verse is John 1:6-8, John the Baptist was sent by God to bear witness to the Light. We have been commissioned by Jesus to "Go" and do the same as commanded in Matthew 28:18. Faith is created when the Word of Christ is preached or proclaimed. God has a role and purpose for us, so we are "Called to Speak" This script has been written to go with the PowerPoint. God's Blessings in a Time of Pandemic (Webinar/Video/Handout) Written and presented by Rev. Jonathan Kraemer. It is divided into 3 parts; Part 1 begins with a question, "Why are we in this mess? The answer becomes clear "disease is part of fallen creation." This section focusses on Blessings coming out of evil and an understanding of God's will. Disease was never God's intention. We reflect on Joseph's story in Scripture, the present time of the Covid-19 pandemic and focus on the good that God works out in all circumstances (Romans 8:28). Part 2 reflects on Repentance as a Blessing and what Scripture teaches about the 2 parts of repentance, contrition and faith. Repentance applies to all, individual, groups, cities, societies. In the Old Testament prophets were sent to Israel so that they would repent. Part 3 focuses on our Eternal Hope, we know that the pandemic will not last forever; all disease and this fallen world will end when Jesus comes again. Scripture teaches that Jesus healing ministry was a preview of what is coming when he comes again. Death and disease have been defeated by Christ and heaven is ours forever. The handout serves as an outline and provides

Scripture readings, discussion and reflections questions for study. The video is 1 hour.

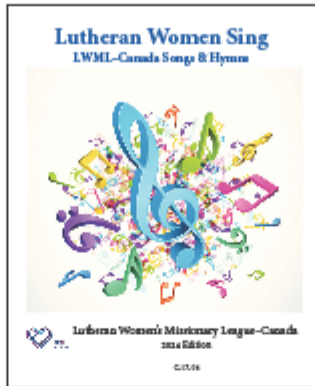
