

This hymn was written by Rev. Sabine Baring Gould in 1865 for Pentecost Sunday. He was a teacher and wanted a marching song to lead the children as they walked to the next village for the church service. He is quoted as saying, "It was written in great haste, and I am afraid some of the rhymes are faulty. Certainly, nothing has surprised me more than its popularity."

This month we remember our veterans by wearing a poppy. We give thanks for all who served or are currently serving our country, and pray that God will protect them all. The words of this hymn can apply to all of us at times, as we all face battles in our own lives. As Christian soldiers we don't have to fight our battles alone, God is with us. 2 Timothy 2:3 tell us to "endure hardship with us like a good soldier of Christ Jesus."
